Projects > Monogrammed Sachet

This sweet little sachet makes a perfect gift!

Materials and Supplies

- Brother Sewing/Embroidery Machine
- Brother Embroidery Thread
- All-Purpose Sewing Thread to match fabric
- Purple crepe fabric: one piece measuring 8" square and one piece measuring 6" square
- Lightweight Cut-Away stabilizer: one piece measuring 8" square
- Tear-Away Stabilizer: one piece measuring 6" square
- Temporary Adhesive Spray
- Small amount of potpourri and poly fiberfill for stuffing sachet
- Basic sewing supplies, including a fabric marking pen or chalk pencil

Note: It is wise to pre-test all fabric markers before using them on fabric. It may be necessary to remove marks before pressing to avoid leaving marks on the fabric.



Instructions

- 1. Secure cut away stabilizer to wrong side of 8" fabric square.
- 2. Set up machine for Embroidery. Hoop fabric, select initial, and embroider in the center of fabric square.
- **3.** Press fabric and cut to equal 6" square.
- **4.** Place monogrammed square on top of 6" tear away stabilizer. Secure with temporary adhesive spray. Mark a line 1 & ½ inch from all raw edges, forming a square on the fabric.
- **5.** Sew several rows of decorative stitches above and below the monogram, keeping the stitching within the drawn lines. Carefully tear away the majority of the stabilizer.
- **6.** Select the second square. Pin to the embellished square, placing right sides together. Stitch around the square using a ½" seam allowance, leaving a 2-inch opening at the bottom for turning and stuffing.
- **7.** Trim seam allowance and clip corners to remove bulk. Turn to right side and press. Lightly stuff sachet with a small amount potpourri, mixed with poly fiberfill.

Note: Wrap the fiberfill around the potpourri to contain it. Hand sew the opening closed.

8. Push fiberfill to the center of the sachet and pin the layers together just inside the marked lines. Stitch along the marked lines with a decorative stitch such as the featherstitch to secure the filling in the center of the sachet.
