

## **Easy Tea Box**

Make your mom smile with this cute Tea Box. Mom can store her tea bags inside and think of you when she uses them! This is so easy to create with the ScanNCut's built-in designs.

## **MATERIALS:**

ScanNCut Machine; ScanNCut Standard Mat; Wood Box; Double-sided Design Scrapbook Paper; Acrylic Craft Paint (Yellow); Paint Brush, 1" (can be foam); Decoupage Medium (any brand); Protected Work Surface; Brayer (optional)

**step 1.** Using paint brush, apply one coat of acrylic paint to the outside of the box. Let dry.

**step 2.** Measure the top of the box to see how big you would like the tea pot image to be.

**step 3.** Go to "Patterns" in the "Home/Clock" section of the ScanNCut library. Select the "Tea Pot with Lid (#AR-E018)." Set the height and width, add both pieces to the mat, and cut the design using the ScanNCut.









## **EASY TEA BOX (CONTINUED)**

**step 4.** Go to the "Alphabet" section of the ScanNCut library. Choose "Alphabet (#FO-A011)." Type the word "TEA" and cut the design using the ScanNCut. Change the size and spacing to fit your box as you'd like.





**step 5.** Go to the "Border" section of the ScanNCut library. Choose "Border (#BO-A001)." Measure the height and distance around the cover and size your border appropriately. Cut the design using the ScanNCut.



- **step 6.** Brush decoupage medium onto the back of the cut tea pot and lid. Center the tea pot and lid (adhesive side down) onto the top of the box. Adhere by smoothing with hands or brayer.
- **step 7.** Repeat "Step 6" using the TEA letters and border, adhering them to the box.
