



- Plastic bags are used in the packing of your machine. Plastic bags are not toys. To avoid the danger of suffocation, keep these bags away from babies and children, and dispose of them correctly.
- This machine is heavy and weighs more than 44.1 lb. (20.0 kg). To prevent possible injuries, at least two people should lift the machine. One person should hold the front of the machine, and one person should hold the back, as shown in the illustration below. Be careful not to trap your fingers when you put the machine down.

• Keep a minimum gap around the machine as shown in the illustration.



- The components included in the box may differ depending on your country.
- · We recommend that you save the original packaging.




While pressing the green paper-guide release lever ①, slide the paper guides to fit the paper size you are loading in the tray. Make sure the guides are firmly in the slots.




Fan the stack of paper well to avoid paper jams and misfeeds.

- Put the paper tray firmly back in the machine.
