Overview

Brother iPrint&Scan allows you to use features of your Brother machine directly from your iPhone, iPod touch, iPad, and iPad mini.

Brother iPrint&Scan supports the following functions:

- Print
- Scan



If your machine does not have a printer or scanner, you cannot use the related print or scan functions of Brother iPrint&Scan.

Download Brother iPrint&Scan from the App Store

You can install Brother iPrint&Scan from the App Store. To take advantage of all the features supported by Brother iPrint&Scan, make sure you are using the latest version.

Device Connections

Connect your mobile device to your Brother machine using one of the following connection methods:

Wi-Fi®

To configure your Brother machine for a Wi-Fi connection, see your machine's Quick Setup Guide.

Wi-Fi Direct®

To configure your Brother machine to a Wi-Fi Direct® network, download any one of the following guides from your model's **Manuals** page on the Brother Solutions Center at <http://support.brother.com>.

Depending on your Brother machine and mobile device, supported connection methods may vary.

Icons

- For iPhone and iPod touch



Tap this icon to select all pages.



Tap this icon to deselect all pages.



Tap this icon to enlarge the thumbnails.



Tap this icon to reduce the thumbnails.

- For iPad and iPad mini



Tap this icon, and then tap **Select All** or **Deselect All** to select or deselect all pages.



Tap the screen to hide or show the operation buttons.

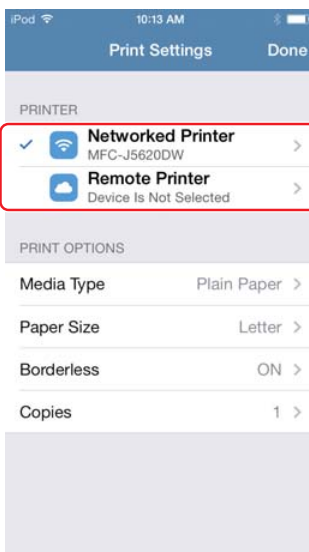
Set a Device for Print

If a different machine is selected or if **Device Is Not Selected** is displayed, follow these steps:

- 1 Tap  or **Settings**.



- 2 Select a device.



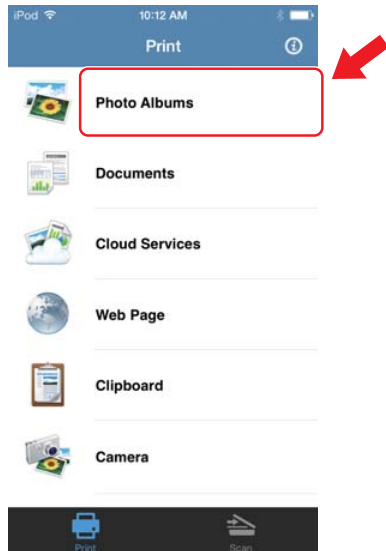
- 3 Set **PRINT OPTIONS** as needed.

- 4
 - For iPhone and iPod touch
Tap **Done** to exit the Print Settings screen.
 - For iPad and iPad mini
Tap outside of the Print Settings screen to close the screen.

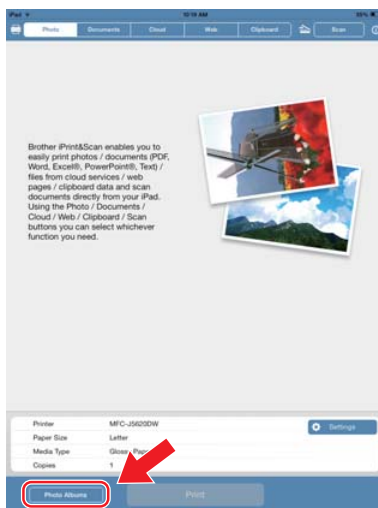
Print Photos Stored on Your Mobile Device

1 Tap Photo Albums or Photo.

- For iPhone and iPod touch



- For iPad and iPad mini



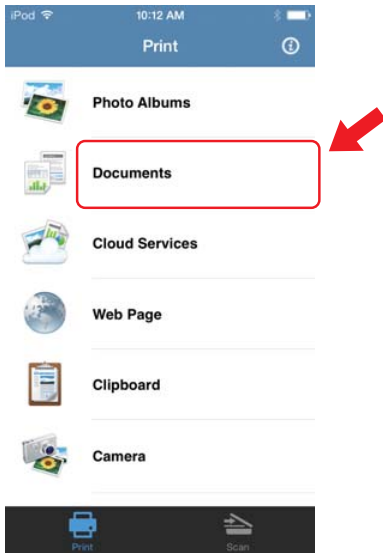
2 Tap the file you want to print.

3 Tap Print.



Print Documents

1 Tap Documents.



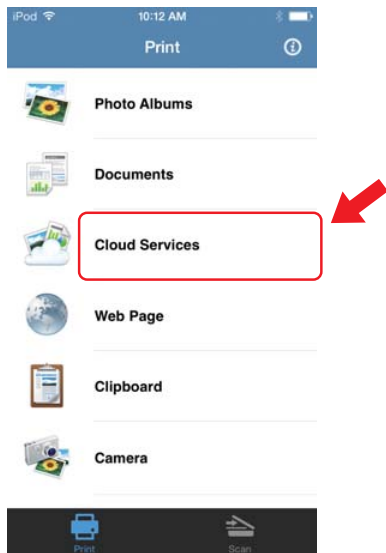
2 Tap the file you want to print.

3 Tap Print.



Print Using Cloud Services

1 Tap **Cloud Services** or **Cloud**.



2 Select the service you want to use.

3 Sign in.

4 Tap the file you want to print.

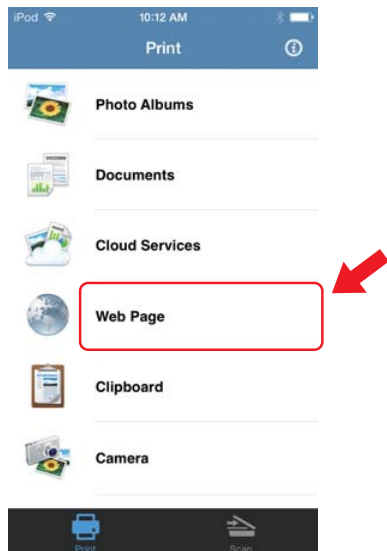
5 Tap **Print**.



Print Web Pages

You can print web pages using the web browser included in Brother iPrint&Scan.

1 Tap Web Page or Web.



2 Navigate to the web page you want to print.

3 Tap Print Preview.



4 Tap Print.

Add a Bookmark to a Web Page

- 1 Navigate to the web page you want to bookmark.
- 2 Tap + .




- 3 Tap **Save**.

Edit Bookmarks

- 1 Tap .
- 2 Tap **Edit**.
 - To delete a bookmark, tap , and then tap **Delete**.
 - To edit the title, tap it, and then edit the title. Tap **Save**.
- 3 Tap **Done**.

Clear Your Entire Browsing History

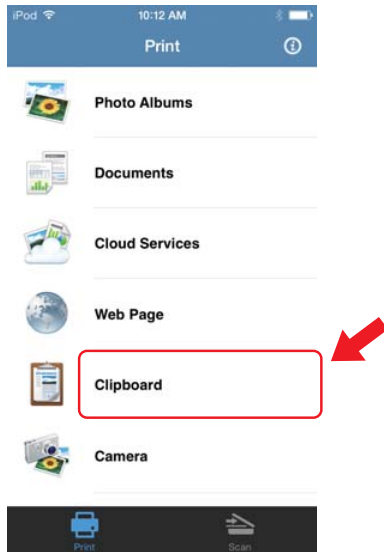
- 1 Tap .
- 2 Tap **History**.
- 3 Tap **Clear**.
- 4 Tap **Clear History**.

Print Data from the Clipboard

You can print data, including photos, text and selected portions of web pages, that is copied to the Clipboard.

1 Copy the data to the Clipboard.

2 Tap **Clipboard**.



3 Tap **Print**.

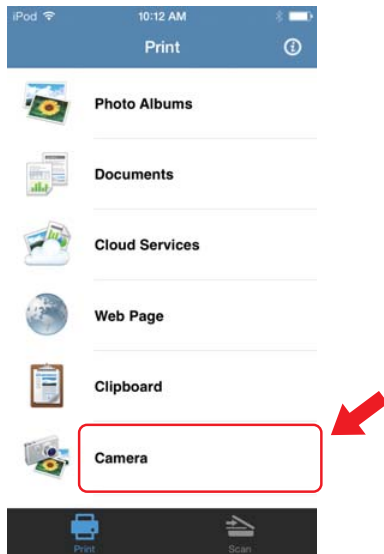


Print Photos Taken with Brother iPrint&Scan



This function is available for iPhone and iPod touch.

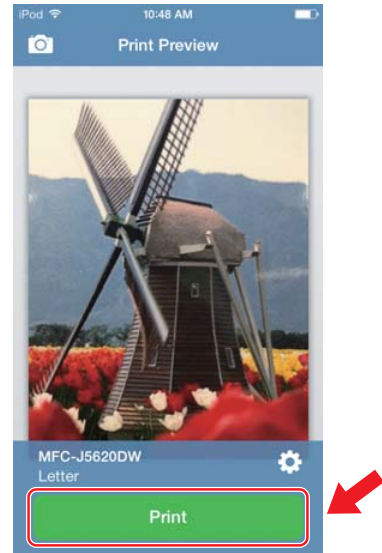
1 Tap Camera.



2 Take a photo.

3 Select **Use Photo** or **Retake**.

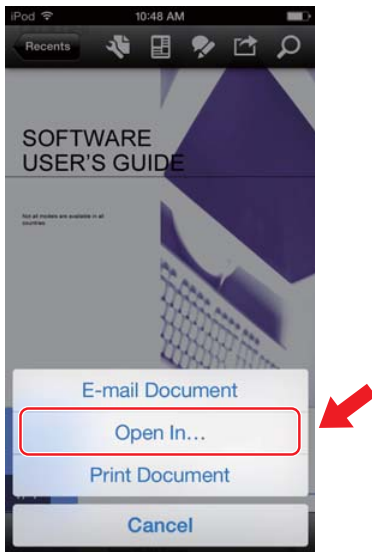
4 Tap **Print**.



Print Photos or Documents from Other Applications

- 1 Navigate to the file you want to print, and then open it in Brother iPrint&Scan.

For example, if you are viewing a PDF using Safari, tap **Open in...**, and then select **Brother iPrint&Scan**.



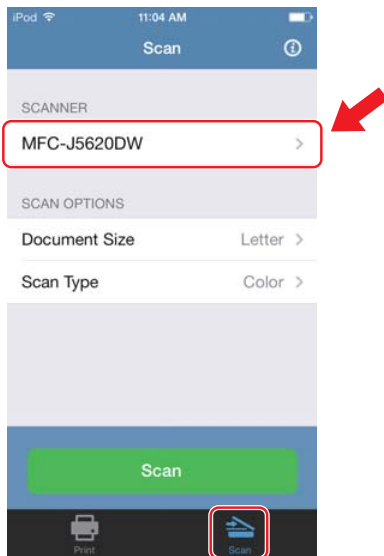
- 2 Tap Print.




Set a Device for Scan

If a different machine is selected or if **Device Is Not Selected** is displayed, follow these steps:

- 1 Select a device.



 If the **Print** screen is displayed, switch to the scan function by tapping **Scan**.

- 2 Set **SCAN OPTIONS** as needed.

Crop the Scanned Image

- 1 Tap .

- To change the size of the box, drag the arrows on the edge of the box.
- Tap inside the box, and drag to move the position of the box.
- To start over and select the size of the box again, tap outside the box to clear the box, and then tap and drag to select the area of the image you want to crop.

- 2 Tap **Done**.

Icons

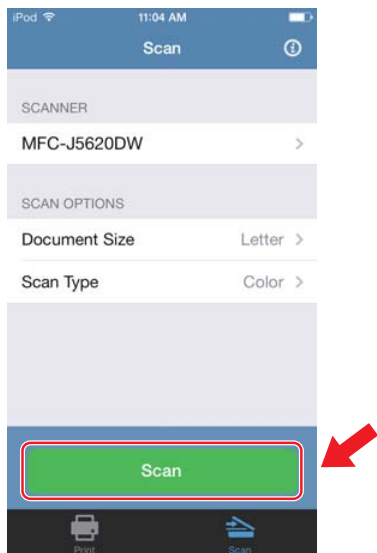


Tap this icon to rotate the scanned image 90° counterclockwise.

Scan Documents

You can scan documents and save them in your mobile device's Photo Albums.

- 1 Load the document to scan in your Brother machine.
- 2 Tap **Scan**.



- 3 Tap .



- 4 Tap **Save to Photo Albums**.

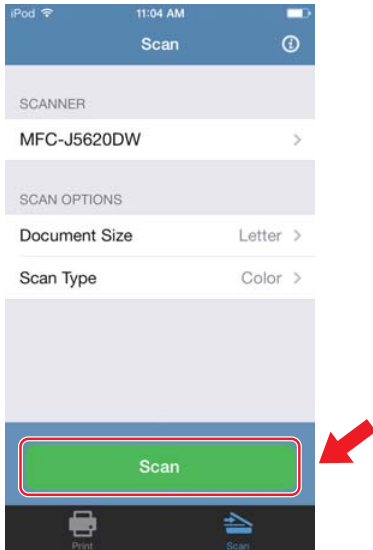


- Each page is saved as a separate file.

Send by Email

1 Load the document to scan in your Brother machine.

2 Tap **Scan**.



3 Tap .



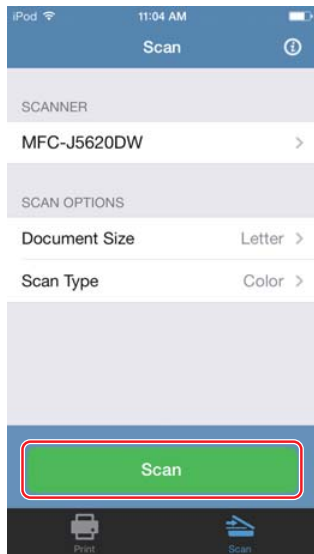
4 Tap **Email as JPEG** or **Email as PDF**.

5 Send a message.

Scan and Save Documents to iCloud

1 Load the document to scan in your Brother machine.

2 Tap **Scan**.



3 Tap .



4 Tap **Save To iCloud as JPEG** or **Save To iCloud as PDF**.

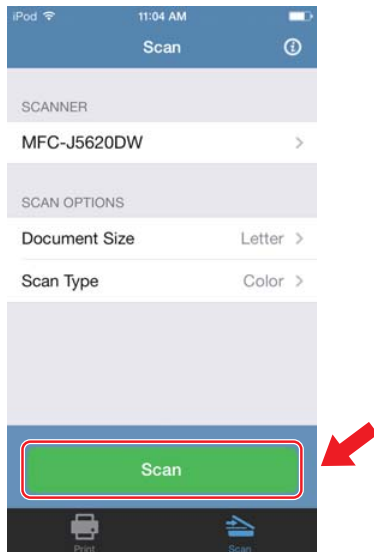


- If you select **Save To iCloud as JPEG**, each page is saved as a separate file.
- If you select **Save To iCloud as PDF**, all pages of the document are saved in one file.
- The Brother ScanViewer app makes searching easier for files saved to iCloud by Mac. This app can be downloaded from the following sites;
 - ScanViewer for iOS: App Store
 - ScanViewer for Mac: Mac App Store

Open, Upload and Share Scanned Images

1 Load the document to scan in your Brother machine.

2 Tap **Scan**.



3 Tap .



4 Do one of the following:

- Tap **Open Using Another App**.
- Tap **Upload to Online Services**. (For iOS 6 only)
- Tap **AirDrop**.



To upload to online services, an online service account must be set up for your mobile device.
