

- Before you can use the printer, you must set up the hardware and install the driver.
- Identify the operating system on your computer (Windows® 95 / 98 / Me, Windows NT® 4.0, Windows® 2000 / XP or Macintosh®).
- The interface cable is not a standard accessory. Please purchase the appropriate interface cable for the interface you intend to use (Parallel, USB or Network). Most existing parallel cables support bi-directional communication, but some might have an incompatible pin assignment or may not be IEEE 1284 compliant.
- If you are an Administrator, configure your network printer settings referring to the **Network Quick Setup Guide** (reverse side).

## **Step 2** Install the OPC Belt Cartridge











## **Step 3** Install the Toner Cartridges



Rock the toner cartridge Pull off the tape labeled 3 to 4 times. 'REMOVE.' and then remove the orange protective cover




## **Step 5** Print a Test Page



Make sure the printer power button is off. Do NOT connect the interface cable




Connect the AC power cord to the printer, and then plug it into the AC

After the printer has warmed up, the Press the Go button. The printer will print a test page. Check that the test page is printed correctly.



### **Print Configuration Page**

To print a configuration page, use a fine ball point pen to hold down the Network Test Button for **less** than 5 seconds.

### Factory Default Setting

If you wish to reset the print server back to its default factory settings (resetting all information such as the password and IP address information), use a fine ball point pen to hold down the Network Test Button for **more** than 5 seconds.
