





Problem	Solution	
The display stays blank after you have turned on the machine.	Check that the batteries are correctly inserted. If the batteries are weak, replace them.	
When the label is printed out, the margin(space) is too large on both sides of the text.	See "Setting Margin" in this users guide and select [Half] or [Narrow] to have smaller margins for your label.	
The machine does not print, or the printed characters are not formed properly.	Check that the tape cassette has been inserted correctly. If the tape cassette is empty, replace it. Check the cassette cover is properly closed.	
The setting has cleared on its own.	The batteries may be weak. Replace them. When power is disconnected for more than three minutes, all text & formats in the display will be lost. Language and Unit settings will also be cleared.	
A blank horizontal line appears through the printed label.	There maybe some dust on the print head. Remove the tape cassette and use a dry cotton swab to gently wipe the print head with an up-and-down motion.	

Problem	Solution
