

Projects > Disney Jacket

Summon the magic of Walt Disney with this colorful jacket!

Materials and Supplies

- [Brother Sewing/Embroidery Machine](#)
- Determine the number of blocks and number of colors needed for the jacket
- Yardage of chosen colors (Will vary with the number of blocks and size of blocks)
- Muslin for the backing
- Black fabric for color blocking tape
- Lining
- [Cut-Away Heavy Weight Stabilizer](#)
- [Brother Thread](#) in colors required by design
- [Brother Bobbin Thread](#)
- Ribbing and Zipper, if needed
- [Brother Embroidery Cards – Disney® Collection](#)



Note: The pattern used for the jacket shown is a baseball style pattern. Any commercial pattern could be purchased and adapted to the color block method.

Instructions

1. Draw around the front (draw 2), back, and sleeve (draw 2) pattern pieces on plain paper. Plan and draw the blocks to be embroidered.
2. Cut fabric for embroidery large enough for the hoop or if larger the size of the block. Stabilize according to directions for the chosen stabilizer.
3. Embroider and cut blocks to desired size and shape.
4. Cut muslin for the fronts, sleeves and back.
5. Lay the cut, embroidered pieces on the muslin, butting the edges together. Pin or baste onto the muslin. Sew the pieces to the muslin at the edge.
6. Use the tube turners if desired or make a tape to create the color block look.
7. Lay the tape over the stitching and top stitch to create the block effect.
8. Finish according to pattern instructions.
