



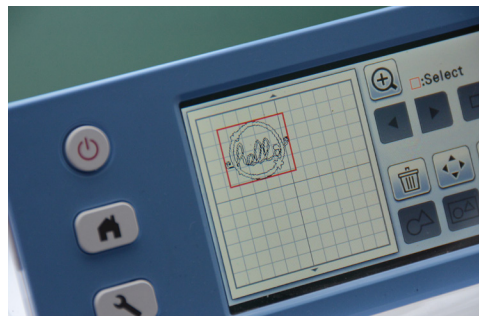
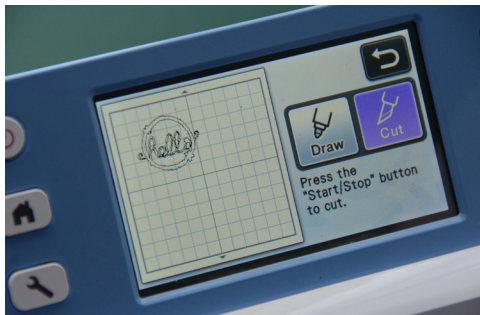

I love the idea of shaker cards, but to get better control of the final look (not to mention to save time), I prefer to create what I call a "faux shaker card." Using my own hand drawn design and some fun sequins and details, I was able to create this card.

MATERIALS:

ScanNCut Machine; Glittered Cardstock; Cardstock; Buttons; Beads; Sequins; Liquid Adhesive; Glossy Sealant; Foam Adhesive

step 1. Draw your word design (including the circle), and scan into the ScanNCut machine. Cut from glittered cardstock.



step 2. Once cut out, adhere using foam adhesive to a circle of blue cardstock. Then, adhere this to a white circle card blank.

Tip: Leave the bottom of the white card flat so that the card will stand up better.

step 3. If desired, stitch around the edge of the blue cardstock for extra texture.

step 4. Place a thin layer of liquid adhesive under the word "hello." Then, apply a layer of sequins. Repeat this step, adding more sequins and beads.



step 5. Place drops of liquid adhesive above the word as desired, and then add tiny and medium sequins as shown.
