Who didn't love flipbooks as a kid? I know I did, and often tried to make one in the corners of my notebooks. Today, we'll show you how to make an updated version of the timeless flipbook. Create your own - with just a few materials and your ScanNCut. You'll love flipping through the pages and showing it off to everyone!

### MATERIALS:

Brother ScanNCut Machine\*; Two different colors of paper; "Flipbook" cut files from <http://Bit.ly/BalzerDownload>; Binder clip; Heavy duty stapler; Two cutting mats (you can use one, but easier to use two)

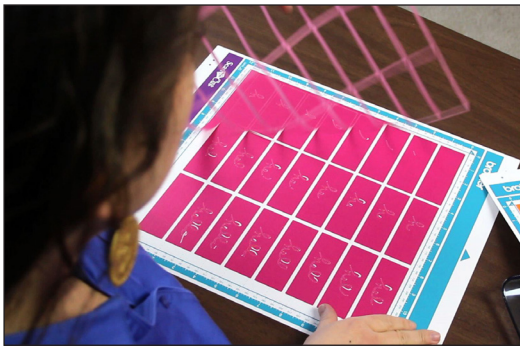
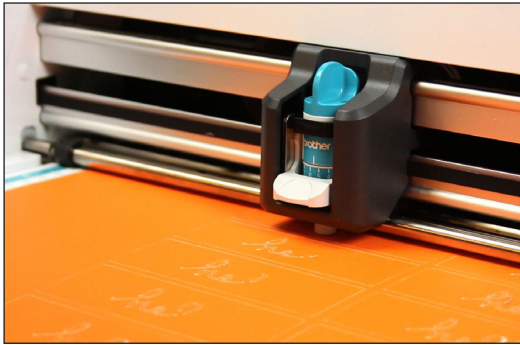
**step 1.** Open the "Flipbook" cut files from: <http://Bit.ly/BalzerDownload>



**step 2.** Load paper into the ScanNCut.

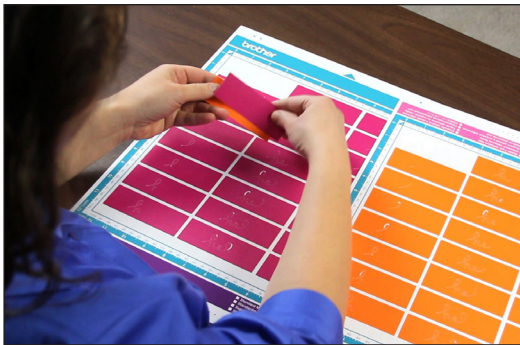


**step 3.** After cutting the two pieces, remove the excess bits from the mat.



**step 4.** Take the first piece of paper cut as this will be cover page of your flipbook.

**step 5.** Intersperse the two (take one rectangle from each in the same manner as the video, <https://youtu.be/iH7LseiGoGg>).



**step 6.** Make sure to take any remaining cut pieces out as you compose your book.



**step 7.** Clip the ends together (to ensure the pages stay together).



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**step 8.** Bind the other side using a heavy-duty stapler.
