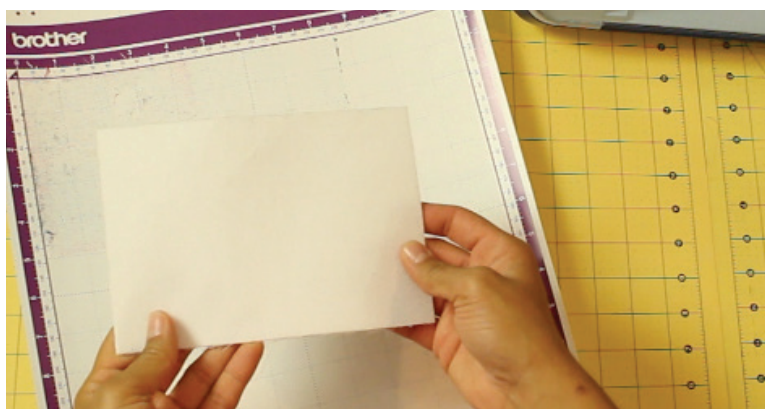
Make an endless collection of custom fish hook earrings using your fabric scraps!

MATERIALS:

Fabric scraps, double sided heavy weight fusible interfacing (I use pellon peltex 72F), Scissors, Iron, sewing machine, and coordinating thread

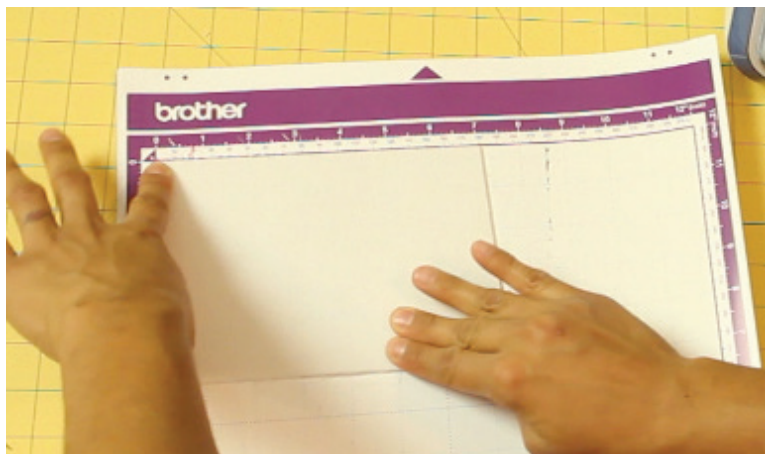
step 1.

Begin by fusing fabrics to the heavyweight double-sided fusible interfacing. The backside of each fabric should be fused to the interfacing. Read manufacturer's instructions on how to properly fuse it. (I used plain white cotton fabric fused on both sides of the interfacing.)



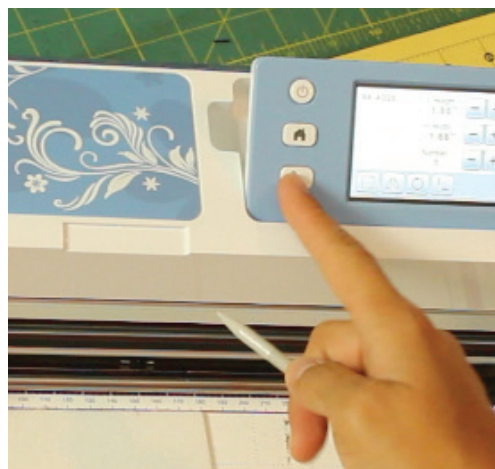
step 2.

Stick it onto your standard mat. Smooth down on all sides to make sure it is secure.



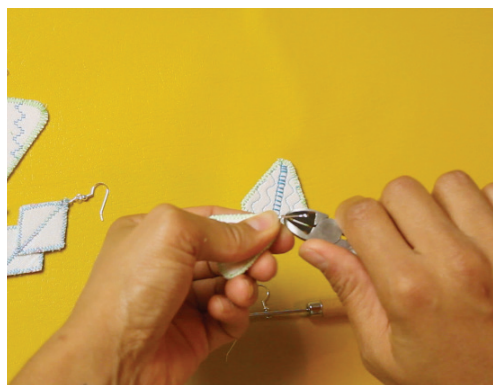
step 3.

Load your mat. From home screen, select “Pattern” and choose any shape you want for your earrings. Adjust the height and width measurements to your liking.



step 4.

Make sure you install the deep cut blade (purple) for this project. You may also need to press the wrench button next to the screen to adjust your cut depth and cut speed settings. (I use Cut Speed: 1 and Cut Pressure: 5.) Play around on a scrap piece until you get it just right.
