









## Anna Aldmon Ultimate New Year's Eve Sew-A-Long

### Warm and Inviting NYE Placemats





This document provides a high-level sequence of how to create the Placemat using the features of the Luminaire embroidery machine. The numbers in this chart correspond to the content of the "Creating Placemat" video.

Topic Area	High Level Steps
<p>1. Create Applique Stars in My Design Center</p>   	<p>Start with an empty USB Stick in the embroidery machine.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Select My Design Center.</li> <li>2. Select Star Shape. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Size to 2.7" wide.</li> </ol> </li> <li>3. Select Line Property. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Running Stitch, select Red Color</li> </ol> </li> <li>4. Apply Line Property to Frame. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Select Bucket icon.</li> <li>b. Touch the line of Star on the screen.</li> </ol> </li> <li>5. Change thickness of Running stitch. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. To .120" Or 3.0mm</li> </ol> </li> <li>6. Save the Placement object. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Select Memory.</li> <li>b. Select USB Drive.</li> </ol> </li> <li>7. Click on Return – repeat steps for Tack Down.</li> <li>8. Select Line Property. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Triple-Stitch; select Gray Color.</li> </ol> </li> <li>9. Apply Line Property to Frame. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Select Bucket icon.</li> <li>b. Touch the line of Star on the screen.</li> </ol> </li> <li>10. Change thickness of Triple stitch to .100" Or 2.5mm</li> <li>11. Save the Tack Down object.</li> <li>12. Click on Return – repeat steps for Cover Stitch.</li> <li>13. Select Line Property. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Zigzag-Stitch select Turquoise Color.</li> </ol> </li> <li>14. Apply Line Property to Frame. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Select Bucket icon.</li> <li>b. Touch the line of Star on the screen.</li> </ol> </li> <li>15. Change thickness of Zigzag stitch to .140" Or 3.5mm</li> <li>16. Save the Cover Stitch object.</li> </ol> <p><i>NOTE: write down the names of the files so they can be "renamed" to something more friendly on the PC.</i></p> <div style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px; margin-top: 10px;"> <p><b>Sequence for Dream Machine:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Save to Memory in My Design Center Edit.</li> <li>2. Proceed to Embroidery Edit.</li> <li>3. Save to Memory in Embroidery Edit.</li> </ol> </div> <div style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px; margin-top: 10px;"> <p><b>For Dream Machine:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Rename file with PHC</li> </ol> </div> <p>On PC – rename the PHX files per video.</p> <p>Create 2 more Applique Star Objects with the following width sizes; Sm Star 2.3" wide</p>


Topic Area	High Level Steps
	<p>Lg Star 3.0" wide</p>
<p>2. Create Star Applique File</p> 	<p>Make sure USB stick with the renamed files is in the machine.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Select Embroidery.</li> <li>2. Locate the Placement, Tack Down and Cover stitch files renamed to P Med Star, TD Med Star and C Med Star. Note, you may also have files for Sm Star and Lg Star as part of completing Topic Area 1.</li> <li>3. Load each file in sequence for the same size star (Sm, Med, Lg) <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Placement file.</li> <li>b. Tack Down file.</li> <li>c. Cover stitch file.</li> </ol> </li> <li>4. Save this group of files to Memory.</li> <li>5. Review the files on the USB stick and note the unique name the embroidery machine has assigned the new file. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Rename the complete file using PC.</li> </ol> </li> <li>6. Repeat the above steps for the other 2 sizes.</li> </ol> <p><b>IMPORTANT: These 3 Applique Star designs are included as part of this design, ready to use for Placemat layout.</b></p>
<p>3. Create Boundary Frame</p> 	<p>This will define the outside boundary of the Placemat.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Select My Design Center.</li> <li>2. Select Square Shape. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Size to 9" x 15"</li> </ol> </li> <li>3. Select Line Property. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Running Stitch, select Red Color.</li> </ol> </li> <li>4. Apply Line Property to Frame. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Select Bucket icon.</li> <li>b. Touch the line of Frame on the screen.</li> </ol> </li> <li>5. Change thickness of Running stitch. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. to .120" Or 3.0mm</li> </ol> </li> <li>6. Save the Placement object. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Memory.</li> <li>b. Select USB Drive.</li> </ol> </li> <li>7. Click on Return – repeat steps for Tack Down.</li> <li>8. Select Line Property. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Triple-Stitch select Gray Color.</li> </ol> </li> <li>9. Apply Line Property to Frame. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Select Bucket icon.</li> <li>b. Touch the line of Frame on the screen.</li> </ol> </li> <li>10. Change thickness of Triple stitch to .100" Or 2.5mm</li> <li>11. Save the Tack Down object.</li> <li>12. Click on Return – repeat steps for Cover Stitch.</li> <li>13. Select Line Property. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Zigzag Stitch select Turquoise Color.</li> </ol> </li> <li>14. Apply Line Property to Frame. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Select Bucket icon.</li> <li>b. Touch the line of Frame on the screen.</li> </ol> </li> </ol> <div data-bbox="1187 1010 1539 1612" style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 10px; margin-top: 20px;"> <p>Size for Dream Machine will be 9" x 14"</p> <p>Sequence for Dream Machine:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Save to Memory in My Design Center Edit.</li> <li>2. Proceed to Embroidery Edit.</li> <li>3. Save to Memory in Embroidery Edit.</li> </ol> </div>

Topic Area	High Level Steps
	<p>15. Change thickness of Zigzag stitch to .140" Or 3.5mm</p> <p>16. Save the Cover Stitch object.</p> <p><b>IMPORTANT: These 3 Frame designs are included as part of this design, ready to use for Placemat layout.</b></p>
<p>4. Prep for Placemat Layout</p> 	<p>The Green Frame will provide the boundary to add the various objects for the placemat. The Grid will help to align the Text.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Select Embroidery from home screen.</li> <li>2. Locate and load the Green Frame. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. This will define the center of the Placemat.</li> </ol> </li> <li>3. Select 1" Grid to display on the screen. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. This will help to line up the words.</li> </ol> </li> </ol>
<p>5. Create Words</p> 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Select Add, locate Alphabet, create the word Happy. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Rotate 90°</li> <li>b. Move to upper right corner, use arrows to fine tune location.</li> </ol> </li> <li>2. Repeat steps for words New, Year, and 2020.</li> </ol> <p><b>IMPORTANT: The Words and Frame are included with this design, ready to use for Placemat layout.</b></p>
<p>6. Add Fireworks design</p> 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Load the Fireworks file (aka 4<sup>th</sup> of July on iBroidery). Purchase from iBroidery. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Select Size and make it as large as the embroidery machine will go.</li> <li>b. Move the Fireworks file to one of the open areas, refer to the picture of the Placemat as a guide.</li> <li>c. Select Rotate and then Select 90°.</li> <li>d. Select Duplicate to make a second copy of the Fireworks.</li> </ol> </li> <li>2. Move and Rotate the Fireworks within the Placemat.</li> </ol>
<p>7. Add Applique Stars – Sm, Med, Lg</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Locate one of the Star appliqué files on the USB Stick that was created in an earlier step.</li> <li>2. To Move all 3 parts (Placement, Tack Down and Cover), they need to be grouped first.</li> <li>3. Once grouped, move the Lg Star as shown in video.</li> <li>4. Rotate the Lg Star following the sample in the video, one object at a time.</li> <li>5. Repeat for Sm and Med Star</li> </ol>

The Dream Machine will see the applique stars as a grouped item which can be moved, sized and rotated as desired.

Topic Area	High Level Steps
	<p>6. Select Memory to save onto USB Stick.</p>
<p>8. Assign new colors on Words, Fireworks and Applique Stars.</p> 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Select the Color change icon within Edit Screen.</li> <li>2. Scroll to the H color, touch it to select it, then select the Fuchsia color. Continue for all the letters of Happy.</li> <li>3. For New – select gray.</li> <li>4. For Year – select turquoise.</li> <li>5. For 2020 - split between Fuchsia and Turquoise.</li> <li>6. Change Cover Stitch Color on Sm and Lg Applique Star.</li> </ol> <p>Select Memory to save onto USB Stick</p>
<p>9. Group all Objects and Create Outline</p> 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Select the Green Frame – make sure it has the red box around it.</li> <li>2. Delete it from screen.</li> <li>3. Select all objects on screen and group them as shown in video.</li> <li>4. Select the Flower icon to create Outline.</li> <li>5. Define the space between the objects and fill. .060"</li> <li>6. Select Memory to save Outline. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. The Outline will be saved in My Design Center within the Stamp Pattern List.</li> </ol> </li> </ol>
<p>10. Load Placement and Tack Down Frame for back fabric</p> 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Select Add button to locate and load the Placement Frame file.</li> <li>2. Select Add button to locate and load the Tack Down Frame file.</li> </ol> <p>Save file to Memory.</p>
<p>11. Create Fill</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Select Add, then My Design Center.</li> <li>2. Create a rectangle 9" x 15" <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. With no line property value.</li> </ol> </li> </ol>

Size for Dream Machine will be 9" x 14"

Topic Area	High Level Steps
	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>3. Select Fill.</li> <li>4. Apply Fill by touching the screen in background space.</li> <li>5. Select Next. Turn on outline, increase size to 150%.</li> <li>6. Set, exit My Design Center, return to Embroidery Edit.</li> <li>7. Add Green Satin Frame.</li> <li>8. Select Memory to save completed file.</li> <li>9. Click on Embroidery to start stitch out.</li> </ol> <p>Refer to Stitch out document and video.</p>
