THE NEED:

Administrators were seeking office solutions to support their printing, copying, and scanning needs. The 115-acres campus – 35 buildings – presented a challenge.

It was quickly determined that a decentralized device infrastructure was needed. Teachers and students required equipment at the point of production – the classroom. This approach would place hardcopy documents within easy reach. The focus would remain on teaching and learning, with no time wasted traveling between buildings.

Small workgroups within the administration building also needed access to printers to produce weekly newsletters, report cards, event calendars, class schedules, release forms, and letterhead. Critical to their desktop publishing efforts was the ability to consistently reproduce the school's multi-color logo.

For this geographically disparate environment, Brother recommended a balanced deployment approach, whereby robust laser printers and MFPs are placed in close proximity to those that need them most.
